TESOL convention in Boston, Massachusetts, March 24-27, 2010

Eligible candidates must:

- ❖ be Mexican citizens (dual nationals holding US citizenship or residency are ineligible)
- ❖ have been MEXTESOL members for at least 2 years and have a current membership
- ❖ be classroom teachers or teacher trainers
- ❖ submit the completed application form electronically
- ❖ have valid passports and visas to travel to the U.S.
- ❖ not have received a US government grant within the past three years

Preference will be given to candidates who are giving a presentation.

The partial grants will provide:

- ❖ Up to US \$1,000.00 dollars
- ❖ Registration to the TESOL convention

Selected candidates will be responsible for registering for the convention in conjunction with MEXTESOL, as well as making their own travel arrangements (airplane and hotel reservations), and securing complementary funding.

Note that grantees will have to submit a brief report at the end of the convention, as well as an account of how the grant funds were spent plus receipts that validate the expenditures.
